

7 - PRE-FORMATTED INTERNET LINKS - MEDLINE_{PLUS}

Thus far, we have been using exclusively, the MEDLINE system of the National Library of Medicine. You would be well served if you were to do nothing more than stay within MEDLINE and become adept at its various retrievals.



However, having grounded oneself in that primary source of scientific information in the bio-medical sciences, we will now start to branch out to other sources on the Internet. We will use MEDLINE_{plus} as a gateway. Again, MEDLINE is a component of the National Library of Medicine, and the library produces various informational “products”; one of which is an expert organization of worthwhile links to various Internet sites on particular medical topics. This is MEDLINE_{plus}, and it is oriented mostly toward informing patients or “consumers” of medicine. From your browser, log to

This takes you to the home page. Note - NLM retains the older procedure of providing a “**Text version**” of the site, which can be a nice feature - simpler and faster.

Various features are available; and you will want to explore each. Select the appropriate **category** for the information which you desire. **Health Topics** is the section which deals with medical problems. Also, you may **search** the site by key word.




