

15 - INTERNET SEARCH ENGINES, PORTALS, BOOKSTORES

As the PubMed search engine is to the MEDLINE database, so Yahoo, HotBot, and other search engines to the entire Internet, which can be seen as one vast database of web-pages. PubMed works only within the MEDLINE database and only on the computers of the National Library of Medicine. Although a person accesses PubMed through the Internet, that program does not search the Internet. That is performed, in various ways, by "Internet search engines". While MEDLINE contains some 11 million records, the Internet, as a whole, contains over 1 billion documents (i.e., web pages) and that is expanding exponentially each year. Unlike MEDLINE, where all of the records pertain to biology and medicine, only a small segment of the Internet relates to those subjects. Thus, it becomes critically important to structure one's search in as precise a manner as possible in order to avoid retrieving a deluge of irrelevant information. In all of the search engines, you can use the basic Boolean operators which were discussed in the previous section; and each search engine will have a sector entitled something like "advanced search features" which explains the particular routines for that program.

15(A) - YAHOO

Yahoo, was the first search engine that was designed for the Internet; and, probably, it continues to be the most popular. Thus, we will discuss this site in greater detail than the others. However, the essential routines are

common to all. Created in 1994, by David Filo and Jerry Yang, Stanford students, it is predominantly a directory of links to Internet sites, with the links organized into subject categories. In 1995, it became associated with Netscape, the Internet browser; and according to their company history, it is housed on the computer of Netscape. From the main menu, you have three options: 1) simply enter your search term in the **query box**, 2) use the **directory of links**, or 3) proceed to **advanced search** functions.

These are simply three different avenues for retrieving the same information. In the following, we will explore each to give you a feel for how these systems function. Keep in mind that when using Yahoo, the scope of your search is restricted to the selection of the organizers who created the directory and, in effect, you are not really searching the web. Rather, you are searching the inventory of links which have been organized by Yahoo; and from those, you can launch out into the Internet.

Option 1 - If you had entered your search term in the **query box** and sent it, then, for our term “**hypertension**”, you are given one **Category** within which Yahoo indexes **53 sites**; and those can be seen by scrolling.

By selecting a **particular category** and then by designating “**just this category**” and redoing your search, you can restrict the retrieval for you term to that particular category.

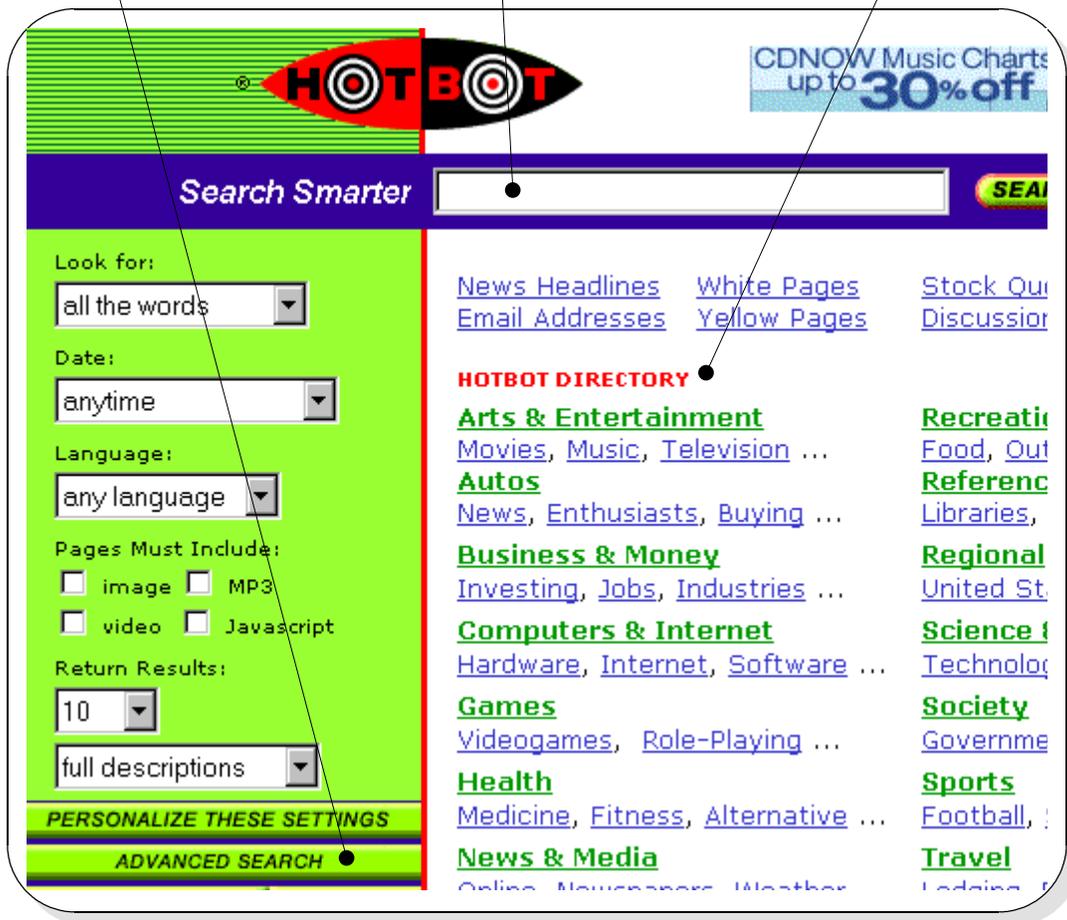

15(B) HOTBOT [<http://hotbot.lycos.com>] HOTBOT, because it builds its data bank by routinely roaming the Internet to collect links to web-sites (presently over 100 million), would be considered an Internet search engine in addition to being an Internet Directory. Originally created as “Inktome” at the University of California, Berkeley, it is now privatized. The structure is similar, with a **query entry box**, a preformatted **directory of links**, and **advanced search** structuring. The breadth of retrieval is much vaster than Yahoo.

15(C) OTHER SEARCH ENGINES AND PORTALS. There are many other Internet search engines; and there is great competition and rapid evolution among them. Only a few others will be identified here, for no other reason, really, than to demonstrate the diversity. Each has different characteristics; and that which will be initially useful for a person may become inadequate as one becomes more skilled.

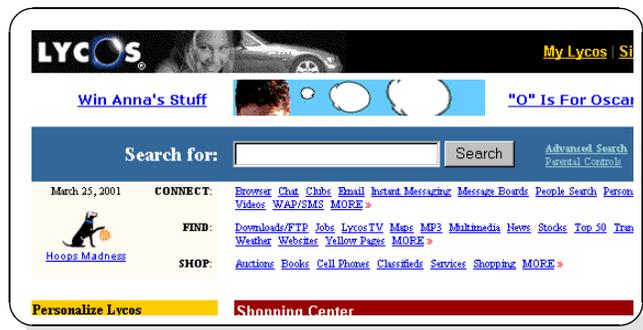
